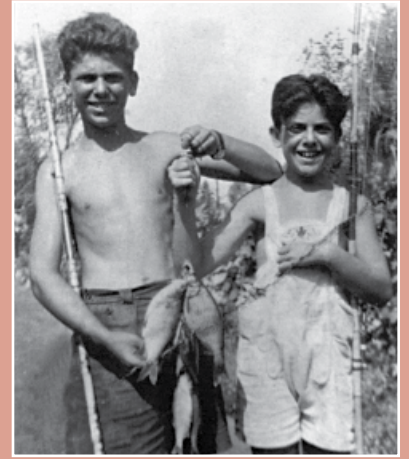

the truth that could allow us to save ourselves from ourselves. His story is painstakingly unembellished so that we will know what really happened.

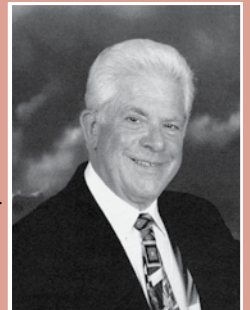
